SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

What is the McLean Electric Scholarship Program?

The Scholarship Program is designed to encourage and recognize the academic achievements of the children of member-cooperative consumers, or student members of the Cooperative.

The recognition will be in the form of scholarships to assist with their post high school education.

How much is the scholarship?

The Scholarship Program will award two scholarships in the amount of \$500. The scholarships must be used for educational costs, and the student must enter a higher education institution in the fall of the school year for which the scholarship is given or be an enrolled higher education student. Checks will be made payable to the school.

The scholarships will be awarded in June 2017.

Who is eligible to receive the scholarship?

Students who are members of McLean Electric or children of members of the Cooperative are eligible.

The applicant must be a student who is enrolled or planning to enroll in a full-time graduate or undergraduate course of study at an accredited, two-year or four-year college, university or vocational/technical school.

The scholarships will be awarded without regard to other awards, loans or financial assistance the applicant may have obtained.

How are the recipients selected?

Awards are based on academic excellence, which includes the following criteria: SAT/ACT scores, grade point average, work experience in school and community activities, a statement by the student explaining his/her educational and career goals, and a written recommendation by a third party.

The Cooperative will be responsible to select two recipients.

What are the recipient's obligations?

Except for the requirements outlined, no obligations will be imposed upon the student as a scholarship award winner. Other than payment of the scholarship, no obligations or liability are assumed by McLean Electric Cooperative.

How can I apply?

To apply, you must complete the required criteria and the scholarship application.

The applicant is responsible for submitting all necessary information to apply for a scholarship.

Applications must be received at McLean's Electric's office no later than **February 24, 2017**.
